All local government jurisdictions have their own tender sites and companies are encouraged to register for these as well as the ones listed below.

Austender

AusTender provides centralised publication of Australian Government business opportunities, annual procurement plans, multi-use lists and contracts awarded. AusTender advertises business opportunities with Australian Government agencies, including defence. Registering a business profile on AusTender will enable this system to generate free automatic notifications via email of the latest opportunities as these are published.

The Entrepreneurs Infrastructure Program (EIP) is an Australian Department of Industry business advice service replacing Enterprise Connect, which may require a co-contribution payment from participating firms. Its focus is to support business management, research connections and commercialising ideas.

Tenderlink is a subscription based business opportunity notification service. It is one of Australasia's central gateways for advertising and managing tenders and other business opportunities. 300 e-portals operate and publish about 40 000 opportunities a year. It has 200 000 registered users and the customer base is largely local government.
